

Medical Policies and Procedures

RETURN A SIGNED COPY OF THIS FORM BY JULY 10, 2010.

FFI does not maintain a medical officer. Any medications or needed medical attention is administered only and solely with the knowledge and consent of the parent.

- All prescription medications must be disclosed to FFI administration.
- Over-the-counter medications, i.e., aspirin, ibuprofen, sudafed, pamprin, will be maintained in the administrative office and can/will be administered to the student ONLY on the consent of the parent.
- Prescriptions must be sent to FFI in the original container with the Dr.'s orders on the label.
- Inhalers may be maintained by the FFI students only if he/she feels confident in the procedures for usage.
- At any sign of injury or illness, the parent will be contacted and/or the child will be transported to the nearest emergency room.
- Parents must sign the "Consent For Treatment" clause, return the health history form and enclose a copy of the child's insurance card.
- All medications, injuries, or health concerns must be documented in the FFI Health Log.
- If a student is determined to be contagious, he/she will be isolated from the other FFI students. If the contagion continues for more than 24hrs, then arrangements must be made to transport the child home.
